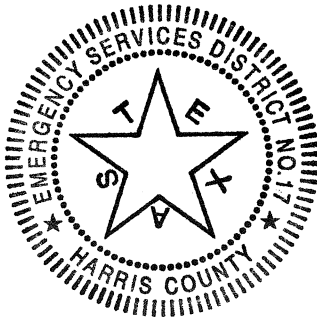
The District will consider and act upon the following matters:

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1. Call meeting to order.
2. To receive public comment.
3. To approve the Minutes of prior meeting(s).
4. To review and take action on financial matters, including financial report, investments, Investment Policy, accounts, depository security and to pay bills.
5. To review and take action on granting exemptions for 2020.
6. To review and take action on amendments/revisions to District budget(s).
7. To review and take action to approve the purchase of capital assets, including apparatus/vehicles, equipment, tools and communications equipment.
8. To review and take action on District obligations, including retiring obligations or incurring obligations for construction, real estate, vehicles and equipment.
9. To receive a report from Fire Chief on Fire Department activity.
10. To review and take action on matters related to COVID-19, including but not limited to meeting procedures, emergency expenditures and continuity of operations per Government Code §418.1101.
11. To review, discuss and take action on Emergency Services Consulting International's evaluation of the District.
12. To review and act on the disposition of surplus and/or salvage property.
13. To review, discuss and take action on any issues related to the repairs, improvement, utilities, permits and construction of District facilities, including engaging construction services, change orders and construction payments.
14. To review, discuss and take action on any issues related to retirement plans or benefits for volunteers.

15. To review and take action on personnel matters, including action on hiring, retention, duties, and benefits [including participation in Texas County and District Retirement System (TCDRS)], including administrative staff, fire suppression staff, command staff and fire chief.
16. To review and take action on real estate, including but not limited to purchase, sale, platting, or permits.
17. To review and take action on any matters regarding dispatch, communications or mutual aid agreements with other agencies.
18. To set the date of the next regular meeting.
19. To meet in Closed Session pursuant to Government Code §551.071 to consult with legal counsel regarding pending or contemplated litigation, settlement offers or on matters which require confidentiality under the Texas Disciplinary Rules of Professional Conduct of the State Bar of Texas and Tax Code §323.3022 to discuss sales tax matters.
20. To meet in Closed Session pursuant to Government Code §551.074 to discuss personnel matters.
21. To meet in Closed Session pursuant to Government Code §551.072 to deliberate regarding real estate matters.
22. To review, discuss and take action regarding matters discussed in the Closed Session.
23. Adjournment.
