

PUBLIC MEETING NOTICE

HARRIS COUNTY EMERGENCY SERVICES DISTRICT NO. 17

Notice is hereby given that **Harris County Emergency Services District No. 17** will hold a public meeting on **July 28, 2026, at 9:30 a.m.** which will be held at the **District Administration Building**, located at **10410 Airline Dr., Houston, Texas.**

The District will consider and act upon the following matters:

1. Call meeting to order.
2. To receive public comment.
3. To approve the Minutes of prior meeting(s).
4. To review and act on financial matters, including financial report, audits, investments, accounts, depository security, lines of credit, resolutions for account access, and to pay bills.
5. To review, discuss and take action regarding amendments to the District's 2026 budget.
6. To review, discuss and propose the District's 2027 Budget.
This is an item to begin the Budget adoption process for the upcoming FY 2027. The District acknowledges the requirement of Government Code §551.043(c)(2) to prepare a taxpayer impact statement when reviewing and adopting budgets. However, certified values are not yet available and the required no new revenue tax rate calculations are not yet available. Therefore, no Taxpayer Impact Statement is included.
7. To review, discuss and propose the District's 2026 Tax Rate.
8. To schedule a public hearing regarding the District's 2026 tax rate and the date of the meeting to adopt.
9. To review and take action on matters relating to an election to be held on November 3, 2026:
 - a. Approve an Order of Election under Texas Tax Code Section 26.07.
 - b. To review and take action to hold an election jointly with other jurisdictions.
 - c. To review and take action to contract with Harris County Elections Office for election services.
10. To consider and take action on such other Orders, Resolutions and related matters as required or appropriate to call for the District election
11. To review, discuss and take action regarding adoption, amendment and explanation of District policies, procedures and standard operating guidelines.
12. To review and take action regarding purchase requests by the Department, including but not limited to capital assets, apparatus/vehicles, equipment, tools and communications equipment.
13. To review and act on disposition of surplus and/or salvage property.
14. To review and act on District obligations, including retiring obligations or incurring obligations for construction, real estate, vehicles and equipment.
15. To receive a report from Fire Chief on Fire Department activity.
16. To review, discuss and take action regarding matters related to the District's Strategic Plan.

17. To review, discuss and act on any issues related to the repairs, improvement, and construction of District facilities, including engaging construction services, change orders and construction payments.
18. To review and act on personnel matters, including action on hiring, retention, policies, duties, and benefits.
19. To review and act on real estate matters, including but not limited to purchase, sale, platting, or permits.
20. To review and act on any matters regarding dispatch, communications or mutual aid agreements with other agencies.
21. To meet in Closed Session pursuant to Government Code §551.071 to consult with legal counsel regarding pending or contemplated litigation, settlement offers or on matters which require confidentiality under the Texas Disciplinary Rules of Professional Conduct of the State Bar of Texas and Tax Code §323.3022 to discuss sales tax matters.
22. To meet in Closed Session pursuant to Government Code §551.074 to discuss personnel matters.
23. To meet in Closed Session pursuant to Government Code §551.072 to deliberate regarding real estate matters.
24. To review, discuss and act regarding matters discussed in the Closed Session.
25. To set the date of the next regular meeting.
